**Sub: Reservation of Seats in Degree Level technical courses for States / UTs lacking in such facilities for academic sessions 2021-22.**

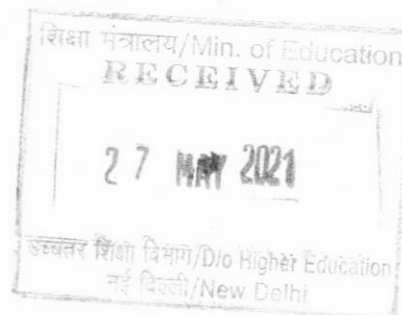
Sir,

I am directed to state that this Ministry has an ongoing scheme of Reservation of seats in Engineering / Technology / Architecture / Pharmacy courses conducted at Degree level technical institutions approved by the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) and Universities for States and Union Territories (UTs) which do not have Engineering Colleges or lack facilities for education in specific fields of Technical Education, and for certain categories including foreign students.

2. At present, these supernumerary seats are available only for those students who qualify JEE (Main) Examination. To bring transparency in the system and making it merit based, the following procedure, which was followed for academic year 2020-21 also, is to be adopted for the academic year 2021-22 :-

- (i) The candidates may apply with CSAB-2021 on recommendations of the nominating agencies or directly apply with the Central Seat Allocation Board (CSAB) - 2021 under the allotted quota for admissions against these seats.
- (ii) The nominating agencies shall share SC, ST and OBCs % that is applicable in their case with CSAB- 2021.
- (iii) CSAB-2021 has to allot seats in these colleges. The admissions against the said seats would be made strictly in accordance with merit for performance in JEE (Main) examination; and
- (iv) There would be no relaxation in this regard.
- (v) MNIT - Jaipur has been entrusted the responsibility of CSAB - 2021 for the academic year 2021-22.

3. The details of the seats allocated in **Degree Level Technical Courses for 2021-22**, in respect of the North Eastern States / UTs and other categories are given in the statements attached.



4. The seats offered in private institutions, according to the AICTE's letter No. 314-1/CCF/RES/94 dated 13.01.95 are free seats, over and above the sanctioned intake strength. These seats are supernumerary in nature and do not affect the total strength / intake of students.

5. The other terms and conditions remain the same as followed during last Academic Year i.e. 2020-21.
