Nomination of candidates for admission to 4-year Degree Course of B.Sc. (Hons.) Agriculture at College of Agriculture, Kyrdemkulai, Meghalaya under CAU for the academic session 2022-23.

Sir,

Nominations are invited from your state for admission to 4-year degree course of B.Sc. (Hons.) Agriculture for the academic session 2022-23. The academic session will commence from 20th September, 2022.

The nominated candidates must have the following minimum requirements:

1. Passed Higher Secondary (10 + 2) with minimum 50% marks in aggregate of PCB/PCMB/PCM/Inter-Agriculture for General & OBC Categories and 40% marks for SC/ST/Third Gender/PwD/In-service categories.

2. The candidates must have attained 16 years of age on 31st August, 2022.

3. The Selection/Nomination of candidates should be made through Competitive Entrance Test conducted by the concerned state.

The Government of India has taken the decision to admit the students from OBC category from the Academic Year 2008-09 in all the centrally funded institutions of higher learning. As per the conditions stipulated in the Government orders, your State is being allotted 03 (one) scats, out of which 02 (two) scats are to be reserved for (UR/ST/SC/PwD) categories as per reservation policy of the State Government and 01 (one) seat is to be reserved for candidates belonging to OBC category for admission to B.Sc. (Hons.) Agriculture for the academic session 2022-23.

While selecting the candidates against this position, your must ensure that the candidate does not belong to Creamy Layer as specified by the Government of India and certificate to that effect from the competent authority recognized by the State Government certifying that candidate does not belong to Creamy Layer will be necessary for the candidate before admission. This may kindly be made known to the candidates well in advance. If the State Government does not find the candidate from OBC category, the OBC seats shall be converted into Unreserved Scats.. This may please be kept in mind.

It is, therefore, requested to send nomination of 03 (three) candidates from your state on or before the 15th September, 2022 to the Dean, College of Agriculture, Kyrdcmkulai, Meghalaya with a copy to the undersigned. The list of nominated candidates should be sent along with the complete bio-data, attested copies of mark sheets, age proof certificate, domicile certificate, OBC/Caste/Tribe certificate (if required), 2 (two) passport size photographs along with a transparent certificate indicating the date of holding Entrance Test, rank of student in the Entrance Test and criteria adopted for determination of merit.

The nominated candidates may be directed to report to the Dcan, College of Agriculture, Kyrdemkulai, Meghalaya on or before 20th September, 2022 along with their original documents and admission fee of Rs. 5580/-(Rupees five thousand five hundred eighty) only for admission to the 1st year B.Sc. (Hons.) Agriculture course.
