Sub:- Submission of information for nomination/sponsoring of Government candidates for admission into B.Pharm and D.Pharm courses at Regional Institute of Pharmaceutical Science & Technology (**RIPSAT**), Agartala, Tripura for the Academic Year 2026–2027.

Sir/Madam,

In inviting a reference to the subject cited above, I would like to inform you that the admission process for the 04 (Four) year Bachelor of Pharmacy (B.Pharm) and 02 (Two) year Diploma in Pharmacy (D.Pharm) (Allopathy) courses at RIPSAT is scheduled to commence during the period from the 2nd week of July, 2026 to the 2nd week of August, 2026 for the Academic Session 2026–2027. Accordingly, the classes for both courses are expected to start positively from the 3rd week of August, 2026.

The last date for admission at RIPSAT is tentatively fixed as 15th September, 2026.

Hence, all concerned sponsoring States/Departments dealing with Higher Education, Medical Education, etc. are requested to sponsor and forward the names of eligible nominated candidates from their respective States as State Government nominees for admission into the B.Pharm and D.Pharm courses at RIPSAT, Agartala, Tripura, in accordance with the seat matrix indicated in the table below and subject to the prescribed terms and conditions for the Academic Session 2026–2027.

TERMS & CONDITIONS FOR ADMISSION IN B.PHARM & D.PHARM COURSES

Minimum Qualification for admission

1. The minimum qualification prescribed for the admission into the Bachelor of Pharmacy (B.Pharm) course is as follows:

- A pass in the 10+2 examination (Science stream) conducted by the respective State/Central Government authorities with English as one of the subjects and Physics, Chemistry, and Mathematics (PCM) or Physics, Chemistry, and Biology (PCB), or any other qualification approved by the Pharmacy Council of India as equivalent thereto.
- Reservation of seats for Scheduled Castes (SC) and Scheduled Tribes (ST) candidates shall be made in accordance with the instructions/guidelines issued by the Central Government/State Governments/Union Territory Administrations from time to time.

2. Admission Fees including caution deposit (Refundable) Rs 3000/- for college & Rs 3,000/- for hostel:-

- Day Scholars – Rs 14,000/- (first year), Rs 11,000/- Subsequent years
- Hosteller – Rs 23,000/- (First year), Rs 17,000/- Subsequent Years
- Registration and Examination fees to be paid to Tripura University (A Central University) (TU), for B.Pharm Course and Tripura Board of Pharmacy Education (TBPE) for D.Pharm Course

3. Inmates of the Boys' and Girls' Hostels of shall compulsorily join the common messing system. The monthly mess fee is required to be paid to the mess manager, and all mess dues must be cleared positively by the 10th day of every

month.

Any boarder refusing to join the common messing system shall not be permitted to continue staying in the hostel.

4. Documents required at the time of admission:

- Nomination Letter/Order/Memo etc. of the candidate issued by respective departments of the concerned State Government.
- Original and attested copy of Date of Birth Certificate or Admit card as age proof.
- Original and attested copy of Mark sheet of H.S (+2) examination, Pass certificate, School Leaving certificate & Migration Certificate of Board
- Caste Certificate, if applicable.
- Certificate of children of Ex- Servicemen/ Armed Forces Personnel, if applicable
- Domicile certificate / Residential certificate/ Permanent Residential Certificate
- Income Certificate from Government Authority in Original
- Disability Certificate from concerned Authority of the State, if applicable
- Medical Fitness Certificate issued by the Government Medical Officer.
- Photo Identity Proof (Voter ID/ Adhaar Card)
- 02(two) recent stamp size photographs
- Surety Bond AFFIDAVIT to be typed in Non Judicial e-stamp paper duly attested by Notary Public in Rs 200/- (As per THE INDIAN STAMP TRIPURA FIFTH AMENDMENT ACT, 2020, SL No 5) during admission time according to course wise by following Gazette Notification No. 1577 dated October 29th 2024.

All the Government nominated candidates are to be informed to take admission physically at RIPSAT, Agartala before completion of admission process as per Govt. decision, during this academic year or as directed by the authority of RIPSAT.

The Institute reserves every right to refuse the admission to any nominated candidates whose academic qualification does not confirm to the qualifications prescribed by the Pharmacy Council of India as per Bachelor of Pharmacy (B.Pharm) Education Regulation 2014 & Education Regulation, 2020 for Diploma Course in Pharmacy respectively.
